We are looking for a trainee to undertake a 2 year development program leading to a BTEC in Pharmaceutical Science and an NVQ Level 3 in Pharmacy.

The applicant must have a minimum of 5 GCSE's grades A -B including Math, Science/Chemistry and English. Due to funding arrangements, we cannot accept individuals who have already completed a funded apprenticeship training scheme.

The post is based at Musgrove Park Pharmacy with approximately 6x weekly block release courses per annum to the Somerset College in Taunton.

The training will be through a working rotation which will include duties in Medicines distribution and stores, Dispensary services, Aseptic production & Manufacturing, and Medicines Information.

Study time is allocated on a weekly basis, but the applicant must be prepared for supplementary study in addition to this outside of working hours in order to complete assignments. College assignments and NVQ work must be handed in on time to meet required deadlines.

Completion of the 2 year course and success in achieving the BTEC and NVQ Level 3 will permit the applicant to apply for registration as a Pharmacy Technician with the General Pharmaceutical Council.

We are looking for a hardworking, highly motivated and organised individual who is accurate in their work and works well both in a team and on their own. This is an opportunity to gain hands on experience in the workplace whilst studying to achieve qualifications. It is an excellent career development opportunity for the future.
