Dear Parents/Carers

Thank you for taking the time to complete the online survey regarding the proposal to move the times of break and lunch. As you can see from the graph at the end of this letter, 65% of the parents who responded preferred Option 2.

We acknowledge that there are some concerns, primarily around the later lunch, and therefore we are trialling Option 2 from Monday 13 June for the rest of this term. Before we make a final decision on the timings, we will consult with staff and students to see how the trial worked.

There are other considerations for the future, for example extended break and shortened lunch, but we would need to balance this with the lunch time House enrichment. Some parents have suggested having a shorter school day and this is something we may consider in the future. Any changes to the start and/or the end of the day would need to be communicated to parents a year in advance and we would also need to take into account work patterns and primary school start and finish times.

Again thank you for taking part in the survey. We will contact you towards the end of term with a final decision.

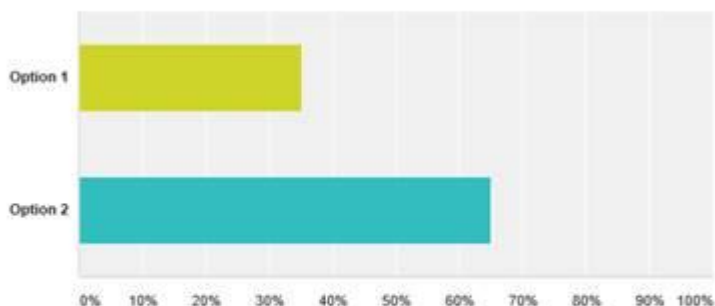
