Dear Parents/Carers

We wish to consult with you as families about the curriculum offer for Year 8 children. We want to ensure that we continue to offer a high quality curriculum that inspires and engages whilst being broad and balanced.

The majority of Year 8 students are telling us that they would like some **choice** over the subjects that they study in Year 9. In addition, we know some families would like us to find a way to return to offering four option subjects, but without increasing the pressure in Year 11. (Current Year 10 follow three option subjects, and those wanting to follow a fourth option study History after school.) We believe that the proposed model outlined below provides a solution to these considerations.

Currently, Year 9 students study ten subjects (listed below) **in addition** to the core curriculum (maths, science, English, RE and PE):

A language – either French, German, Spanish or Mandarin Geography History Art Dance Drama Music Computing Food Technology

The proposal is to choose five subjects **from this list** to continue to study in Year 9, which will allow more lesson time in each subject before students take their option choices for Year 10.

By giving you and your child choice about what they study in Year 9, we can give more time to those subjects which your child finds engaging, therefore deepening knowledge and understanding in subjects they might later go on to take at GCSE. It also means that we can reinstate the FOUR options for GCSE with some/most students able to take one GCSE early at the end of Year 10. This is designed to spread the pressure on students and avoid the intensity of doing everything in Year 11 whilst still giving them the breadth and choice they have wanted.

Thank you in advance for taking the time to give your views. It is important that we balance the views of as many parents as possible and your feedback will determine the curriculum for future children at The Castle School.

Choice 1 National Expectation.

All students need to take at least one of these subjects through to GCSE in Year 11.

Many students will wish to choose more than one; this can be through choices 2, 3, 4 and 5.

Choice 2 First GCSE. To be taken at the end of Year 10 if this is right for your child.

Most students will take the actual GCSE for this subject at the end of Year 10.

If the consultation finds in favour of this model we would then ensure that families have up to date subject reports alongside a Choices Evening in January in order to provide advice and guidance.
