# Hotel Klein Wien

# Sunday 14 April

- Meet at school at **0915** (ready load luggage etc...)
- Coach will leave by 0930 for Gatwick Airport
- Breakfast & lunch at own cost

## Outbound Flight:

- Check in opens at **1355**
- Flight departs at **1555**    **BA2610**
- Flight arrives in Naples at **1935**
- Group to travel by coach to Hotel Klein Wien in Sorrento between 2145 and 2200 (Cold Buffet evening meal due to late arrival)



# Monday 15 April

- Breakfast at 0730 in Hotel
- 0830 coach departs for Mount Vesuvius – time to walk to the crater and have a look across the bay of Naples
- 1230 coach departs for Pompeii
- Lunch in Naples
- 1815 – Return to hotel
- Dinner at 1900



# Tuesday 16 April

- Breakfast at 0730 in Hotel
- 0840 – Minibus to Marina Piccola Harbour for Ferry to Capri
- 1030 – boat trip around Capri
- Time in Capri to shop, get lunch and take Funicular Railway to Capri Town (2 Euro single)
- Afternoon in Sorrento – free time
- 1630 – Ice cream making and tasting session
- Dinner at 2030



# Wednesday 17 April

- Breakfast at 0830 in Hotel
- Morning in Sorrento
- 1245 – coach departs for Solfatara
- 1415 – Visit to Flavian Amphitheatre
- 1530 – Visit to Temple Serapis
- 1700 – Visit to Herculaneum



# Thursday 18 April

- 0700 – breakfast at hotel
- 0800 – coach departs for Rome
- 1200 – arrive in Rome, time for lunch
- 1330 – Guided tour of Colosseum
- 1515 – Guided visit of the Forum

- 1700 – Coach departs for airport





# Thursday 18 April

## Return Flight:

- Check in opens at **1820**
- Flight departs at **2020** **BA557**
- Flight arrives at Heathrow Airport at **2155**
  
- Group to travel by coach to Castle School by around 0230 - 0300 dependent on queues at airport and traffic



# Meals

- Students will need breakfast/lunch on the first day whilst travelling
- Hotel provides HALF BOARD so students will need to purchase lunch each day
- This has already been accounted for in the cost and students will be given 10 Euros each day for this
- Water is provided during evening meals at the Hotel – other drinks can be purchased if you wish
- **NOTE - most cafes etc... will charge a higher price if you choose to sit indoors or on a terrace etc... You can ask serving staff about this if not sure**

# Food at the Hotel Klein Wien

- **Continental Breakfast (buffet)**– breads, jams, cereal, toast, yoghurts, juices, hot drinks
- **Evening meal** – set meal and traditionally Italian
  - **Starter** – Pasta Dish
  - **Main** - meat or fish with a form of potatoes
  - **Desert** - fresh fruit, cake, ice cream

# What should I pack?

- **€100** spending money to cover cost of snacks, drinks and extra things mentioned plus gifts?
- Luggage tag (paper one will be provided by travel com[any) attached to suitcase.
- Comfortable footwear for walk up Mt Vesuvius (trainers or walking boots).
- Comfortable clothes (layers)
- Sun cream and (waterproof) coat just in case
- Valuables are the students responsibility
- Plug Adapters

# Suitcases

- Each student is allowed **one** piece of hold baggage of up to 23kg in weight and **one** piece of hand baggage
- Students could be charged if their baggage weighs more than the recommended amount or if they have more than one item for hold/hand baggage.
- **No liquids, sharp objects (and medication if can be avoided) to be placed in hand baggage – should only contain passport, valuables, EHC card etc...**
- Students should arrange to share hairdryers/straighteners to save space.

# EHIC Card

- You should all remember to pack this in your hand luggage
- This provides free healthcare to the holder whilst abroad.
- You should carry yours with you at all times

**If not valid due to Brexit,  
Insurance does provide cover**



# Code of Conduct

- Money, passports, EHIC and other valuables e.g. Phones are the **responsibility of the student** – avoid taking all money out every day etc..
- No smoking or drinking of alcohol
- No unsupervised swimming or visits to the beach
- Check in with staff at times asked to – free time in the evenings, but must follow instructions from staff as to when they should be in their rooms and lights are out
- Students must be in groups of 3 minimum and carry a mobile phone
- All students will eat breakfast and evening meals together
- Mobile phones – check usage (staff will have a school mobile)
- Students will be reminded by staff about sun cream/hats etc.. But must be responsible themselves
- Do not attempt to bring alcohol, tobacco, explosives, knives etc..
