Activity: College Visits/Careers Leader: Mrs Corbett

The aim of the day is to equip students with information to help them make informed post-16 choices regarding college courses and apprenticeships. The day will include a visit to either Bridgwater & Taunton College or Richard Huish College. Students have already selected where they would like to go.

Students visiting Bridgwater & Taunton College on Tuesday 8 October will be joining students from other schools as part of the college's taster day. Students will need to register online and select which taster session they would like to attend. The college will be providing transport.

Students visiting Richard Huish College will participate in subject taster sessions in the morning and return to school for a presentation from a representative from Next Steps South West on Level 3 options. Students will work on their career action plan during period 5.

The timings for the college visits are as follows:

  Cannington campuses. Students will return to school by 3.00pm.
- Richard Huish College Tuesday and Wednesday
  Students to arrive at school for the normal time. Coaches will take students across to the college leaving at 9.30am and will return to school for 12.45pm. The Next Steps South West presentation will be from 1.00-1.30pm.
