**Year 9 Art students ONLY** are invited to a trip to the Tate Britain Art Gallery in London on Tuesday 8 October.

Leave school at 7.30am and return by 7.30pm (approx). Cost: £17.50

As students who have opted to study Art in Year 9 you are invited to join us on a trip to the Tate Britain Art Gallery in London so see and experience Art first hand. As students who have chosen to study Art and who might be considering continuing into GCSE in Year 10, this trip gives you a fantastic opportunity to experience Art first hand in a gallery setting.

Students need to meet at Bridgwater and Taunton College (SCAT) bus layby at 7.20am to leave at 7.30am, arriving in London at around 11.00am. We will visit Tate Britain Gallery which houses the national collection of British Art including classic paintings as well as more contemporary pieces. You will have a task to complete at the museum which we will then follow up in class with further development and presentation.

At each gallery, students will be given some guidance to help interpret the exhibits; they will have some free time to explore, and will complete tasks that can be added to one of their coursework units next year. We will leave London at 3.30pm and hope to be back at school by 7.30pm (approx).

Studying artists and learning about the world of art is an important aspect of any of our GCSE courses, therefore it is highly recommended that all Art students attend this trip, which will provide an introduction to some of the ideas and images we study in the GCSE course, as well as being an enjoyable day out.
