## **Castle in the Community Concert**

We are thrilled we are able to join together for the Castle in the Community Concert on Wednesday 27 March at 6:30pm in the main hall.

This is a wonderful concert that showcases our talented musicians, our work together and the positive impact it has on arts and the community.

Your child has been rehearsing for the concert and we would like to invite you to attend. The evening will involve performers from our choir, orchestra, woodwind group, mini orchestra, steel band, Community Steel Band and performances from Trull, Bishopls Hull, Bishop Henderson and Parkfield Primary schools.

## Tickets

Tickets are £5 and will be restricted to 1 ticket per family. For example, if you have two siblings performing you will be eligible for 1 ticket. We are aware that not all families will be able to watch this concert live as we have more student performers than tickets available.

We are planning to film the concert and can make the recording available to you after the show.

NB: <u>Tickets will go on sale on Monday 4 March at 8:30am from Student Reception</u>. Please note these tickets are sold on a first come first served basis, 1 ticket per family and will not be available before this date and time.

Primary schools will be allocated their ticket allowance and will sell their tickets to their students independently.

## Rehearsals

There will be two rehearsals. The first on Tuesday 26 March during school hours from 9:10 - 12:30 in The Castle School main hall and the second on the day of the concert from 4:30pm-5:30pm, also in the school hall. Students will need a packed tea to eat during the after-school rehearsal. After a short break, all Castle students should meet in the Music Department (J6) at 6.00pm, wearing school uniform unless told otherwise. We are aiming to finish at 8:30pm.
