Dear Parent/Carer

Lancaster House is organising a trip to Ninja Warrior and shopping trip to Cribbs Causeway Bristol. The trip will firstly be open to Lancaster House members and to other Houses if places are not filled, at a later date.

The trip is on Thursday 14 December – we will meet at 3:35pm, leaving school at 3:45pm to give students and staff enough time to get changed. We will depart from BTC lay-by at 3:45pm and will travel Cribbs Causeway with Ridlers Coaches where we are booked into Ninja Warrior 6-7pm session and introduction at 5:40pm. During shopping time students may decide to buy something to eat or prefer to bring a packed tea. I hope to back at school (BTC lay-by) by 9.30pm. If there is any change to the timings, we will ask students to contact parents en route.

The price of the trip will be **£20**. The cost includes transport, admittance to Ninja Warrior and required socks. Students to bring their own money if they wish to do some Christmas shopping.

There are **60** spaces available. If we have more than 60 students apply then names will be placed in a ballot. If your child would like to go on the trip please give consent via **ClassCharts** by Wednesday 22 November. We will then confirm your child's place and ask for payment.

Please ensure that we have your up to date emergency contact details and any relevant medical information for your child, as this information is taken from our school database.

School trips are covered by the Trust insurance policy. Please be aware that:

a) except for visits abroad, insurance arrangements are the same as for students in educational establishments, i.e., that the Trust can only insure against the proven negligence by the Trust and/or its employees; and

b) the Trust is a member of the RPA (Department for Education risk protection arrangement) which provides personal accident cover (see copy of the policy on the school website for details) but you may consider taking out your own personal accident cover to supplement this if appropriate.
