This trip is open to all current students in years 7, 8, 9 and 10. You do not have to be studying French, but a willingness to participate in all activities with a language element is essential. In the event that the trip is oversubscribed, priority will be given to those who are studying French.

This exciting opportunity includes the following in the price:

- Return travel from school (coach and ferry/Eurotunnel)
- Full board and accommodation in specialist accommodation for school parties at the PGL Chateau de Grande Romaine
- A full daily programme of excursions to include:
  - O A day in the Euro Disney theme park one park ticket.
  - o Cruise down the Seine River to spot all of the key monuments in Paris.
  - Ascent of Tour Montparnasse get a 360-degree view of Paris from up high perfect for taking pictures of the Eiffel Tower and a chance to learn lots about the history of Paris using the interactive screens around the tower.
  - A guided tour of the famous Stade de France (the renowned football stadium where national and international matches take place).
  - o A chance to see the Sacré Coeur and the beautiful arts area of Montmartre.
  - Prep, buy, create! Plan a French lunch including all of the French words needed to buy the ingredients at a market. Next, head back to the centre and enter the toughest of competitions to win the title of "Best Lunch".

  - Shopping in a hypermarché learn more about France by trying to find all the products on Madame Hopkins' French shopping list. (And if you want to, an opportunity to buy some souvenirs to take home with you).

The total cost of the trip is estimated to be £693, based on 40 students going.
