The learning objectives are:

- To look at the personal values in sexual relationships.
- The responsibility of contraception and the risks of unprotected sex. Knowledge of the main types of contraception, how to use these and where to find them.
- Being aware of your body and changes that may occur.
- Being aware of the choices around birth control and the choices around delivery during labour.
- To know that there are legal responsibilities that come with parenthood and how these affect adult life.
