## The Duke of Edinburgh's Bronze Award 2025 - 26

If you would like your son/daughter to take part in the Duke of Edinburgh's Bronze Award please complete and return the attached enrolment form and make payment of £125 and deposit of £50 (to cover use of school equipment) no later than <u>Friday 17<sup>th</sup> October</u>. Payments can be made via Arbor, please go to the "shop" section and you will find DofE set up as a product. If for any reason you are unable to make this payment, please get in touch using the details below.

The amount of £125 covers the cost of registration for the award including a user account for the E D of E website and costs associated with the training days, practice expedition, assessed expedition, assessor's fees, campsite fees, transport etc. The £50 refundable deposit covers the use of school equipment, including the use of stoves and tents. The deposit will be refunded when all group equipment for the expedition group to which your child is assigned is returned in a clean and dry condition. Neither amount covers the costs of personal equipment for the expedition or costs associated with the skill, volunteering or physical sections of the Award.

Please be aware that your son/daughter must be able to attend all of the training sessions and expedition weekends so that they can safely complete the award. Missing any dates could result in them not being allowed to continue with the expedition, in which instance **no refund** will be given. Likewise, if a participant decides not to continue with the Award they will **not** be eligible for a refund. (If they are absent due to illness or family emergency then I will help them to catch up on what they have missed.) Dates of meetings, training and expeditions are as follows:
