Dear Parent/Carer

On **Thursday 24 March** the History Department has organised a trip to Glastonbury Abbey as part of the local study for the history FGCSE student, on which students will have a 1-hour exam (summer 2022). We will be leaving school at 9.00am (students should register in their form room and then meet on the tennis courts) and returning at 3.00pm.

The trip is designed for students to gain a more specific knowledge of the site that will be assessed in the exam in Year 10. Therefore, we will be working all day. Students need to be prepared for this by bringing a pad of A4 lined paper and pens and pencils.

While on site at Glastonbury Abbey we will complete a physical remains map task, spend time looking at the archaeological finds, have a session on digital reconstructions and interviews with characters from the Medieval period. We will be spending a substantial amount of time outside, therefore it is suggested that students bring the following:

- Appropriate clothing (not school uniform) with a coat and/or sun cream.
- Sensible footwear and warm socks.
- A packed lunch (not money as there is nowhere to buy food etc).
- A charged mobile phone with a camera or a charged digital camera.

The cost of the trip is $\pounds 16.50$ which covers the coach journey and entry into Glastonbury Abbey. In order to finance this trip, we ask that parents/carers make a voluntary contribution. We very much hope you are able to contribute; if we do not get enough contributions we will have to cancel the trip. As the school receives a grant for students currently receiving free school meals, we do not require a contribution from these students as this can be funded from the grant; however, parental consent is still required through the online Scopay system. If you have any queries on the funding of this trip, please contact the school's Finance Office.

Payment for this trip can be made using the online Scopay system, <u>https://www.scopay.com/castleschool-somerset</u>. Please note, you will need to tick the consent box before you can pay. If you are unable to pay online you can pay by cash/cheque (made payable to The Castle School) or by credit/debit card (either in person or over the phone) but you still need to login to Scopay to give consent and confirm that you are satisfied with the arrangements outlined in this letter. If you do not wish your child to participate you will need to login and give a reason why. We value your feedback and will take this into consideration in our future planning. The deadline for payment/consent is **Monday 7 March 2022.**

Please ensure that we have your up to date emergency contact details and any relevant medical information for your child, as this information is taken from our school database.
