

The Castle School Computing Hub

The Castle School is part of a network of **Computing Hubs** across England and provides computing training and resources for secondary and primary schools. The National Centre for Computing Education (**NCCE**) was set up in November 2018 by the Department for Education (**DfE**) to increase the number of pupils in schools and colleges who study computer science at GCSE, AS and A level, particularly girls and those in disadvantaged areas, and to ensure that there is a strong pipeline of digital skills in England.

CPD for teachers

The Castle School Computing Hub delivers **Computing CPD to teachers with differing levels of expertise in Computer Science**. The NCCE Computing Quality Framework

The NCCE's Computing Quality Framework (CQF) is intended to help primary and secondary schools review their progress in developing an exemplary computing curriculum. The Framework takes schools through each aspect of the computing curriculum with access to the CQF reporting functions and helps them access the NCCE's support and resources for progress. The development of the Framework was funded by the DfE. As schools progress through the NCCE's Computing Quality Framework, certificates and awards can be achieved to indicate progress. The final certification is the Computing Quality Mark awarded to the school.
